



Latest Arrangements in Times of Weather Warning Signal

(From 1st Jun 2024)

Please refer to the public announcements through radio and television for the latest information when Hong Kong is threatened by severe weather conditions such as tropical cyclones and thunderstorms. The following latest arrangements will be implemented at Kumon centres in times of weather warning signal.

Remarks: ✓ Centres operate as usual ✗ Classes will be cancelled (Please exchange homework on the opening day of Kumon centres.)

- If the signal is in force **before class starts**, please follow the above arrangements.
- If the signal is in force **when students have already set out for centres**, students should go to safe places as soon as possible.
- If the signal is in force **during classes**, students should remain in the centre until the end of class and when conditions are safe for them to return home. (Except Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 and Extreme Conditions or above)

Notice:

- Cancelled classes will not be made up. Parents can exchange homework on the opening day of Kumon centres.
- If the centres open when the signal is hoisted, instructor will ensure to open the centre and arrange staff to look after the students who have arrived at the centre.
- Please feel free to contact your Kumon centre during typhoons and rainstorms for enquiries. The lines may be busy. Please be patient.
- The above arrangements are applicable to Kumon centres in Hong Kong and Macao.
